You are invited to join the Student Resource Scheme (SRS) for 2017. From 1 January 2012, the scheme has operated under the policy and guidelines of the Department of Education and Training FNM-PR-018: Student Resource Scheme. The scheme is still supported and approved annually by the School's Parent and Citizens Association (P&C), is still managed by the school and still operates in accordance with Section 51 of the Education (General Provision) Act 2006.

Student Resource Scheme 2017

The scheme is voluntary and you are under no obligation to join. However, please be aware that books, materials and consumables required under the scheme are *not funded by school grants*. Therefore if you do not wish to join the scheme you are still responsible for providing your child with the items that would otherwise have been provided by the scheme to enable your child to engage with the curriculum.

The provision of this scheme ensures that well-resourced learning by our students remains our key focus. The scheme is not a fundraiser for the school. Its purpose is to provide you, the parent, with a cost effective, value for money alternative to purchasing textbooks, resources, consumables and materials elsewhere, through the school's bulk purchasing process. Fees are paid directly into the child's classroom account to buy essential resources and materials used in his/her classroom.
